1. Controller

2. Principles and legal bases

Personal data are processed lawfully, fairly and transparently, for specified purposes, only to the extent necessary and with appropriate technical and organisational security measures. Main legal bases are performance of a contract, compliance with legal obligations, consent and legitimate interests.

3. Supporter display package orders

Data may include name, email address, package fee, currency, supporter tier, public-site language, newsletter choice and language, customer type, company name, billing name and address, tax or EU VAT number, VAT rate/treatment, VIES result and request identifier, IP address, Terms/Privacy acceptance timestamps, request for performance within 14 days, payment provider, transaction identifiers and technical invoicing statuses.

Purposes: creating and performing the supporter display service, reconciling payment, managing entitlements and communication, preventing abuse, complying with tax/invoicing/accounting obligations and handling legal claims. The supporter package is not a game pre-order, so this processing is not performed for pre-sale or advance-payment management.

Legal bases: Article 6(1)(b) GDPR for contractual performance; Article 6(1)(c) for invoicing, accounting and tax obligations; Article 6(1)(f) for security, fraud prevention and legal claims. Contract/transaction data are retained until relevant claims expire; accounting and tax records for statutory periods, generally at least 8 years where applicable.

4. Payment processing

4.1 Stripe

HUF and EUR card payments may be processed through Stripe. Data necessary to create and reconcile payment may include email address, amount, currency, order reference, billing country, customer type and technical metadata. Full card details are entered directly on Stripe's secure interface and are not received or stored by LittleShark Marketing Kft.

4.2 OTP SimplePay

Where OTP SimplePay is enabled for HUF payment, data required to create and reconcile payment are transmitted to SimplePay. Full card details are entered on SimplePay's secure interface and are not stored by LittleShark Marketing Kft.

5. EU business orders and VIES

For a business established in another EU Member State, the EU VAT number may be validated through the European Commission VIES service. The validity result, validation timestamp and returned request identifier may be stored to document EU B2B tax status and reverse-charge treatment.

6. Automated invoicing – Billingo

After successful payment, Billingo may create a normal invoice for the supporter display service. Data transmitted may include billing/company name, billing address and country, email, tax/EU VAT number, order reference, package fee, currency, applicable VAT or reverse-charge treatment, payment provider and necessary transaction information.

Provider: Billingo Technologies Zrt., 1133 Budapest, Árbóc utca 6., 1st floor, Hungary. Purposes include partner and invoice creation, payment-status recording, statutory retention and Hungarian NAV Online Invoice reporting. If automatic invoicing fails, the invoice may later be created through an administrator retry.

7. Supporter display and unique editing link

Data may include display name, optional website URL, optional logo, optional supporter message, the administrator-edited public version of the message, public-profile display preference, separate message-publication preference, consent and withdrawal timestamps, separate profile and message moderation statuses, technical hash of the unique editing token and email-delivery status.

Purposes: performing the purchased supporter display service, reviewing customer-provided public content before publication, publishing it after approval, reviewing later changes again, and preventing publication of unlawful or clearly inappropriate content. Processing of profile display data is necessary for performance of the contract; the Service Provider also has a legitimate interest in content-safety and moderation review. Public publication of the optional supporter message, and spelling, stylistic or moderation edits necessary for publication, are based on the supporter's separate voluntary consent.

Public profile display and publication of the optional supporter message are separate choices. Consent to publish the message may be withdrawn at any time through the editing interface; after withdrawal, the message is no longer shown on the public Supporters Wall, and withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal. The message entered in the profile may remain stored and editable until the supporter deletes it or the purpose for processing the underlying profile data ends. The unique editing link provides access to modify display settings and must therefore be treated as confidential.

8. Supporter confirmation email

After successful payment, one supporter confirmation email is sent to the order email address. Hungarian public-site orders receive Hungarian email; all other language versions receive English email. The message may contain package information, the unique editing link, PDF copies of the legal documents relating to the contract and, when available, a secure invoice-download link. If automatic invoicing fails, a subsequently issued invoice may need to be delivered separately.

9. Newsletter

Data: email address, selected newsletter language, subscription date, status, source and withdrawal date. Purpose: development news and related project information. Legal basis: voluntary consent. Newsletter consent is not a condition of the supporter service.

10. Development survey

Survey data may include email address, optional name, demographic categories, ratings, optional free-text feedback, language, survey version, timestamps and consent data. Purpose: development research and aggregate analysis. Legal basis: voluntary consent. Personally identifiable survey data are generally retained for up to 3 years unless earlier deletion or longer statutory retention is required.

11. Contact requests

Data: name, email, subject, message, submission time and necessary technical logs. Purpose: receiving and answering enquiries, administration and legal claims. Retention: generally up to one year after closure unless longer retention is necessary.

12. Game account and external authentication

On release, entitlements may be linked to Google or Apple accounts. Data may include external user identifier, name, email, linking time and security logs. Purposes are user identification, game/supporter entitlement management, abuse prevention and access recovery. Legacy of Sol™ does not receive the external-account password.

13. Cookies, analytics and technical logs

Strictly necessary cookies/local storage may be used without consent; analytics and marketing technologies activate only after required consent. Security logs may include IP address, timestamp, browser identifier, operational events and errors.

14. Data security

The Controller applies access controls, encrypted transmission, logging, backups and permission management. Full card details are processed in the selected payment provider's secure environment and are not stored by the Controller.

15. Data subject rights

Data subjects may request access, rectification, erasure, restriction, object to legitimate-interest processing and request portability where applicable. Consent may be withdrawn at any time. Requests: info@legacyofsolgame.com. Requests are handled without undue delay, generally within one month.

A complaint may be lodged with the Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH), and judicial remedies are available.

16. Amendments

This notice may be amended when the service, payment or invoicing providers, processors or legal environment changes. The current version is available on the website.
