

New Hungarian story-driven space strategy game Legacy of Sol™ is in development

The independent project by LittleShark Marketing Kft. takes players from humanity's first expansion across the Solar System into the interstellar era, combining real-time fleet control, colonies, research and a decision-driven narrative.

Legacy of Sol™ is a story-driven space strategy game developed in Hungary. As a commander, the player directs research vessels and fleets, surveys planets, establishes colonies, develops technologies and shapes humanity's future through strategic decisions. The game is being developed for PC in Hungarian and English, with a targeted release in the final quarter of 2027.

From the Solar System to nearby stars

The campaign begins with the player's appointment as a commander. The player takes control of the first Solar research vessel, surveys Mars and begins humanity's expansion throughout the Solar System. Research, shipbuilding, resource management and orbital infrastructure gradually form a deeper strategic system.

Jump technology opens access to nearby star systems. In the interstellar era, exploration is joined by diplomatic, commercial and military situations. The first publicly revealed alien civilisation is the Aelari; further story developments will be presented later.

Real-time strategy with a personal story

Legacy of Sol™ does not separate narrative from strategic gameplay. Missions, dialogue, reports and cinematics are directly connected to fleet status, research, colonies and earlier decisions. Situations may be resolved through diplomacy, trade or military force, and choices can continue to influence the campaign later.

The game is being developed by the small independent Hungarian team at LittleShark Marketing Kft. The project combines more than 25 years of software-development experience with a passion for story-driven strategy games and classic science fiction.
